Invited Guest Speakers

Douglas N. Goetz, Ph.D., CPPM, CF, President and CEO of GP Consultants

Dr. Goetz has extensive experience as a Property Administrator within the Department of Defense. He has served on the faculty of the Defense Acquisition University (DAU) in Dayton OH and previously the Air Force Institute of Technology (AFIT) at Wright Patterson AFB, Ohio for nearly thirty years. He has traveled extensively through the United States and overseas researching the application of the Government Property Management Requirement. Dr. Goetz has experienced Property Management up close and personal in the war zones of the Balkans and Iraq – as well as far flung operations in Japan, Guam, Turkey and Saudi Arabia, to name just a few locations. Based upon his research he has written and published over 100 articles, and multiple textbooks.

Charles Waszczak, CPCM, Faculty, GP Consultants

Mr. Waszczak is a 14-year NPMA member, Ohio Valley Chapter delegate and former VP. He is a 33-year member of NCMA and a Lifetime Certified Professional Contracting Manager (CPCM); a DoD Acquisition Corp member and retired member of the Armed Forces. He has taught contracting and acquisition courses for Defense Acquisition University (DAU) and has provided performance support and consulting to DoD and other Government agencies.
